The Plan

- Each parish will receive an allocation of \$100,000 plus \$5.10 per capita, based on pre-Katrina census.
- Generators w/ hookups & fuel tanks are to be used for parish designated Critical Facilities.
- GOHSEP will maintain an additional fifteen (15) GOHSEP owned generators.
- This equates to a project total of ~ \$30,000,000

The Plan (cont.)

- GOHSEP's fifteen (15) 140 kw trailer-mounted generators:
 - Six (6) generators will be used for emergency needs and housed at the State Emergency Operation Center in Baton Rouge.
 - Each of the nine (9) GOHSEP regions will receive one (1) generator each to assist in servicing parishes in their region on an as-needed basis.
