4 Parishes (3 Katrina & 1 Rita) - 100% of Debris Recycled or Reused (No Debris Disposed in C&D Landfill)

4 Parishes (2 Katrina & 2 Rita) - 90-99 % of Debris Recycled or Reused (Less than 10% Disposed in C&D Landfill)

2 Parishes (1 Katrina & 1 Rita) - 80-89% of Debris Recycled or Reused (Less than 20% Disposed in C&D Landfill)

4 Parishes (3 Katrina & 1 Rita) - 50-79% of Debris Recycled or Reused (Less than 50% Disposed in C&D Landfill)

6 Parishes (4 Katrina & 2 Rita) - 1-49% of Debris Recycled or Reused (Greater than 50% Disposed in C&D Landfill)

1 Parish (Rita) - 0% of Debris Recycled or Reused (Debris Disposed in C&D Landfill)

Recycled or Reused indicates that debris was managed via burning, chipping or grinding. Ash from burning of vegetative debris was used as a soil amendment. Wood chips from grinding operations were used as a soil amendment, interim cover, for erosion control or for fuel.
